Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

(Fall Semester 2022)

How can I prevent myself from getting COVID-19?

The College strongly recommends following CDC prevention guidelines, including:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds,
 especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- Be mindful of space and distance.

Effective August 31, 2022, masks are to be worn in any indoor space on campus when more than one person is present.

What if I am feeling COVID-19 symptoms?

If you are experiencing <u>symptoms</u> of COVID-19, test <u>immediately</u>. Self-test kits are available on campus in Flakes Hall, Room 102. You may also call Metro Nashville's COVID-19 Information Hotline at 615-862-7777 from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. (CT) Monday through Friday for information on getting a free test.



What if I have been exposed to someone who has COVID-19?

- If you are experiencing <u>symptoms</u> of COVID-19, test <u>immediately</u>.
- If you may have been exposed to COVID-19 and do not have symptoms,
 wait at least five full days after the possible exposure before testing. (If you test too early, you may be more likely to get an inaccurate result.)
- Self-test kits are available on campus in Flakes Hall, Room 102. You may also call Metro Nashville's COVID-19 Information Hotline at 615-862-7777 from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. (CT) Monday through Friday for information on getting a free test
