

Fresh Start Initiative Borrower Acknowledgement Office of Financial Aid, Griggs Hall

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On April 6, 2022, the U.S. Department of Education announced that it would eliminate the negative effects of default for borrowers who defaulted on their federal student loans prior to the pandemic payment pause. This initiative, called "Fresh Start" will enable borrowers with defaulted federal student loans to regain Title IV HEA federal student aid eligibility, including Federal Pell Grants and campus-based aid like Federal Work-Study. This acknowledgement must be signed and dated from the student or parent (parent acknowledgement only required if applying for a Direct Parent PLUS loan) and will remain on file for three years after the end of the award year the student last attended American Baptist College.
